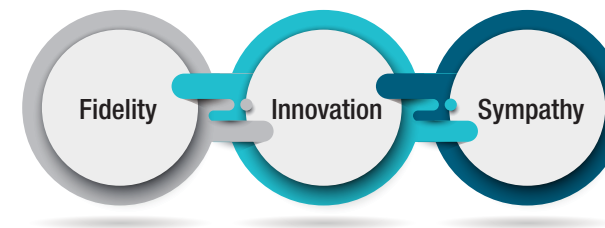
Vision

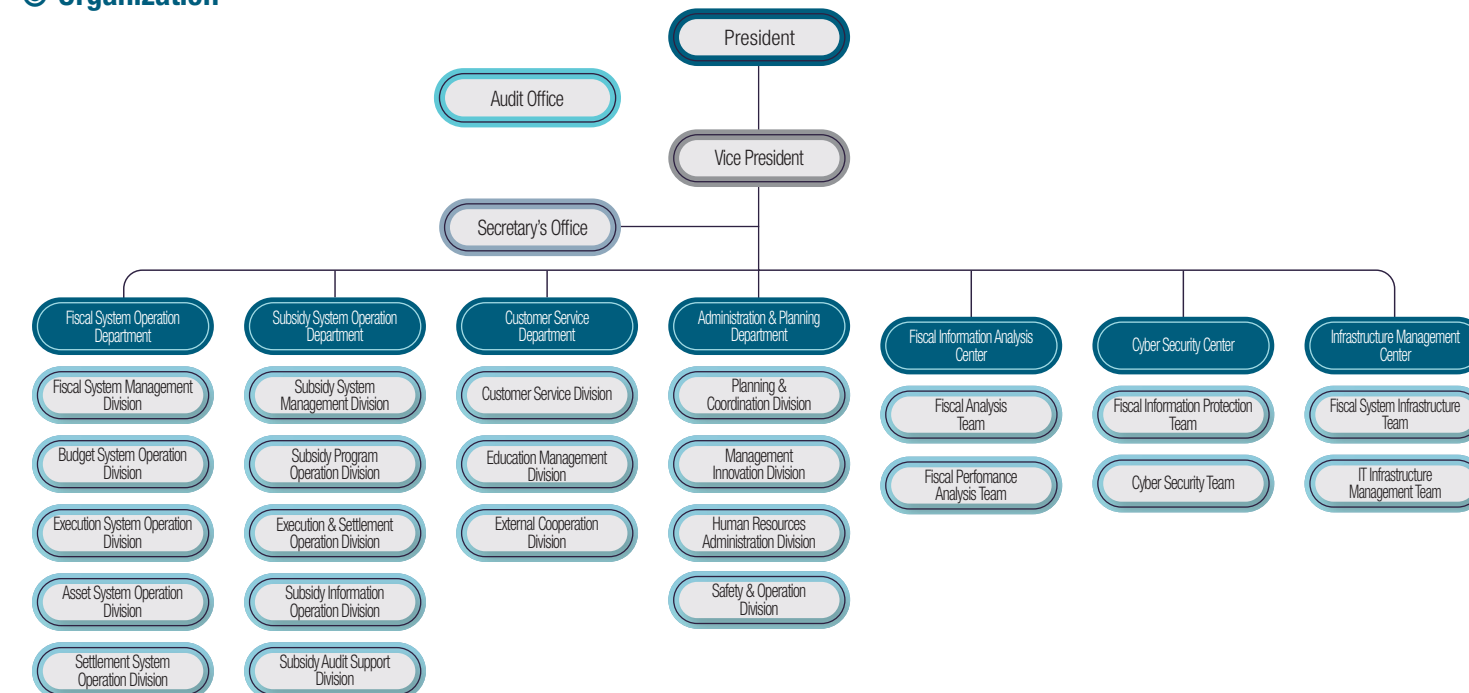

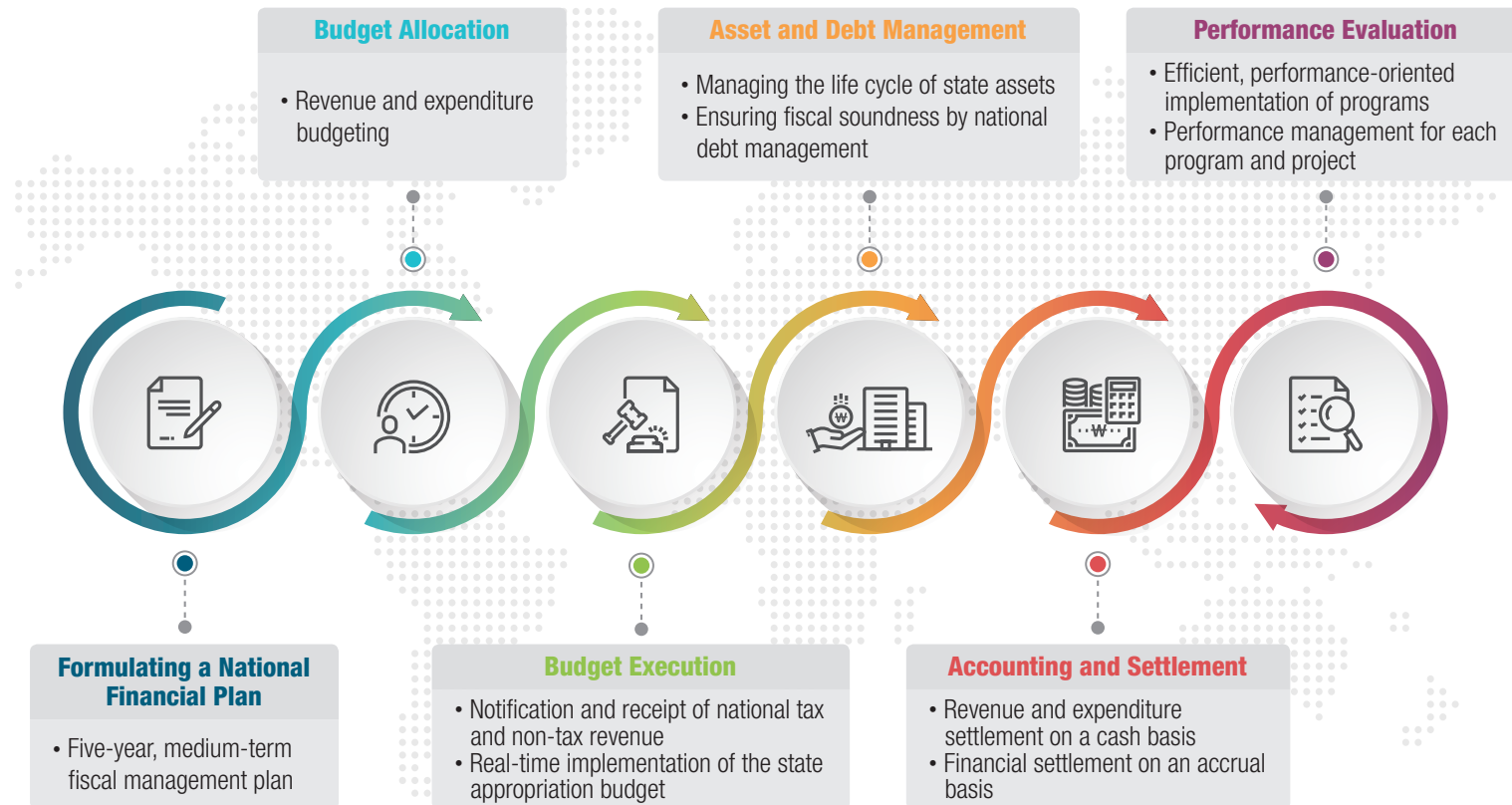

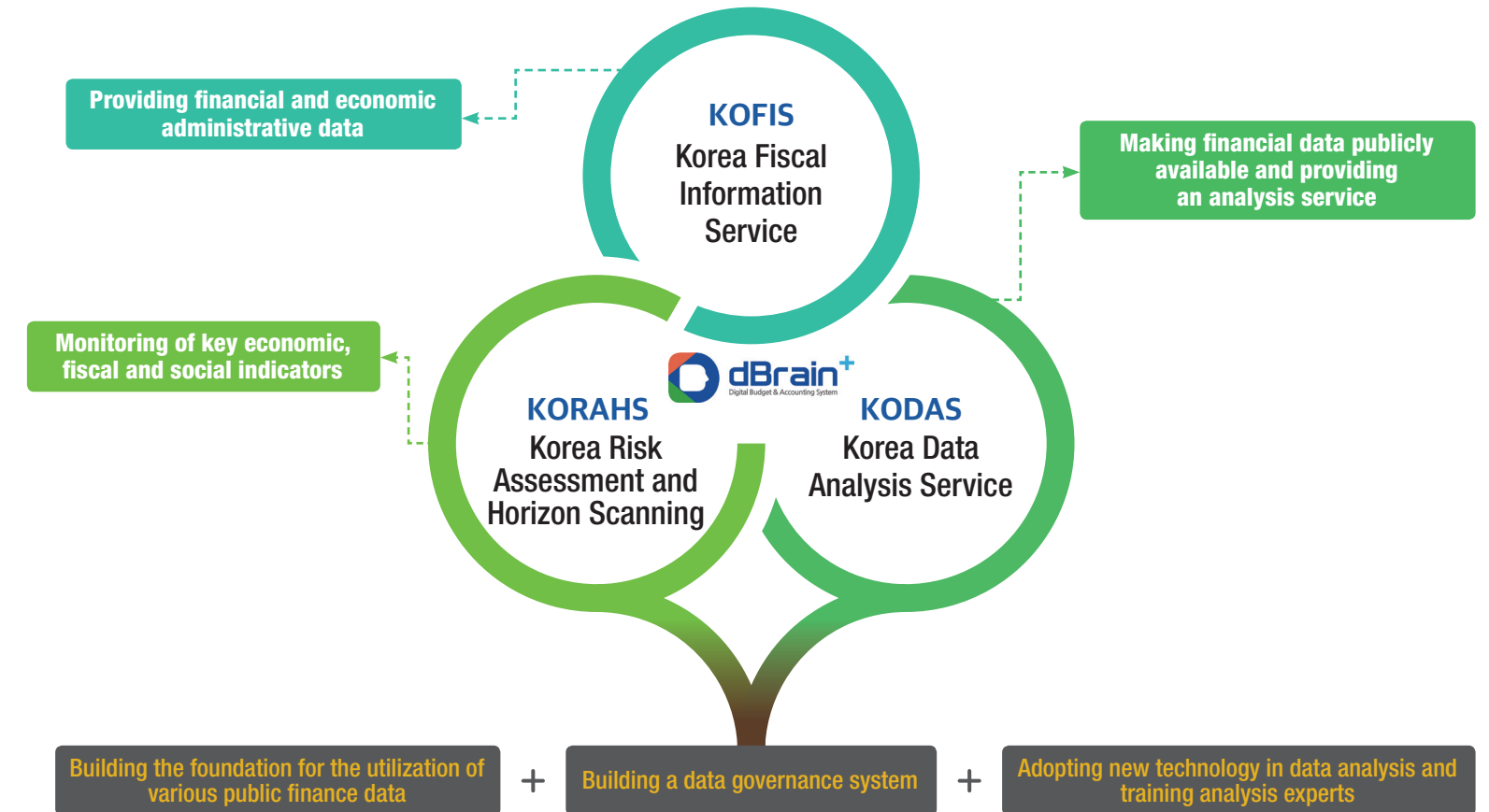
We enhance the efficiency of public finance tasks with dBrain+, the backbone of national finance.

- dBrain+ is an integrated financial management information system where all financial processes are conducted online and national financial information is linked and analyzed.
- We manage and analyze finances in greater detail and support rational policy making by incorporating all the innovative achievements of the national public finance institution, such as a program budget system and double-entry bookkeeping accrual system.



dBrain+ allows users to utilize high-quality financial data via KOFIS, monitor major financial indicators using KORAHs, analyze the combined data linked with KODAS.

We improve the convenience and efficiency of government subsidy programs and prevents duplicate or inappropriate receipt of government grants.

- We standardize, computerize, and integrate the entire processes of government subsidy programs, and improve the efficiency of subsidy administration through online processing.
- Central and local government officials and public-private businesses are provided with “subsidy services that fit my needs,” and duplicate or improper receipt of subsidies is prevented through step-by-step verification.

Improving Work Efficiency

Through standardization and computerization of subsidy program procedures, a one-stop service on subsidy programs via e-naradoun is provided to the public.

The entire process of subsidy administration is carried out in e-Naradoun

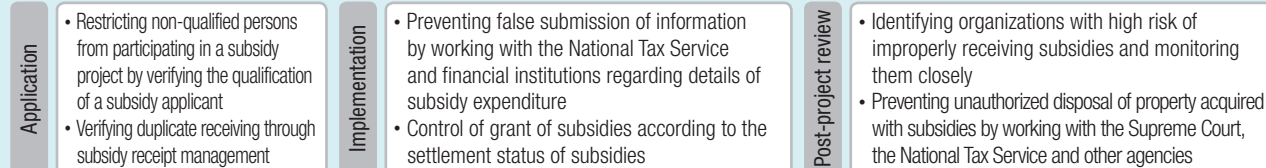


- ① Integrated provision of dispersed subsidy information
- ② Managing each task of a project by the central and local government offices up to final implementation by the private-sector party that runs the project
- ③ Enhancing work convenience with online processing

Subsidies are no longer government funds wasted without a purpose

We prevent duplicate or inappropriate receipt of subsidies by closely verifying all phases of subsidy projects from application to screening, selection, execution and settlement.

Verifying a project in all stages of subsidy administration

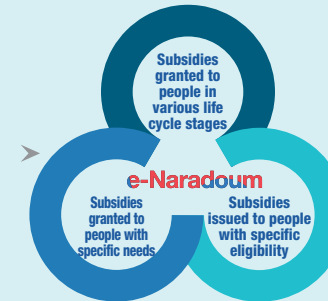


Expanding Transparency

Subsidy information transparently disclosed to the public.

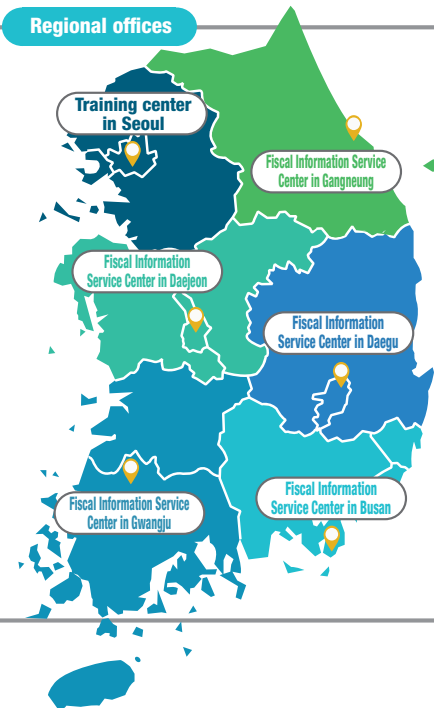
We provide information on subsidies for the public in various life cycle, people with specific qualifications and projects with specific needs.
We post information on organizations that receive subsidies of more than 10 million won. Information on real estate and other important assets that have been acquired with subsidy funds, as well as subsidy-related statistics, can be verified.

Select the curriculum and fiscal information service center after logging in to e-Naradoun

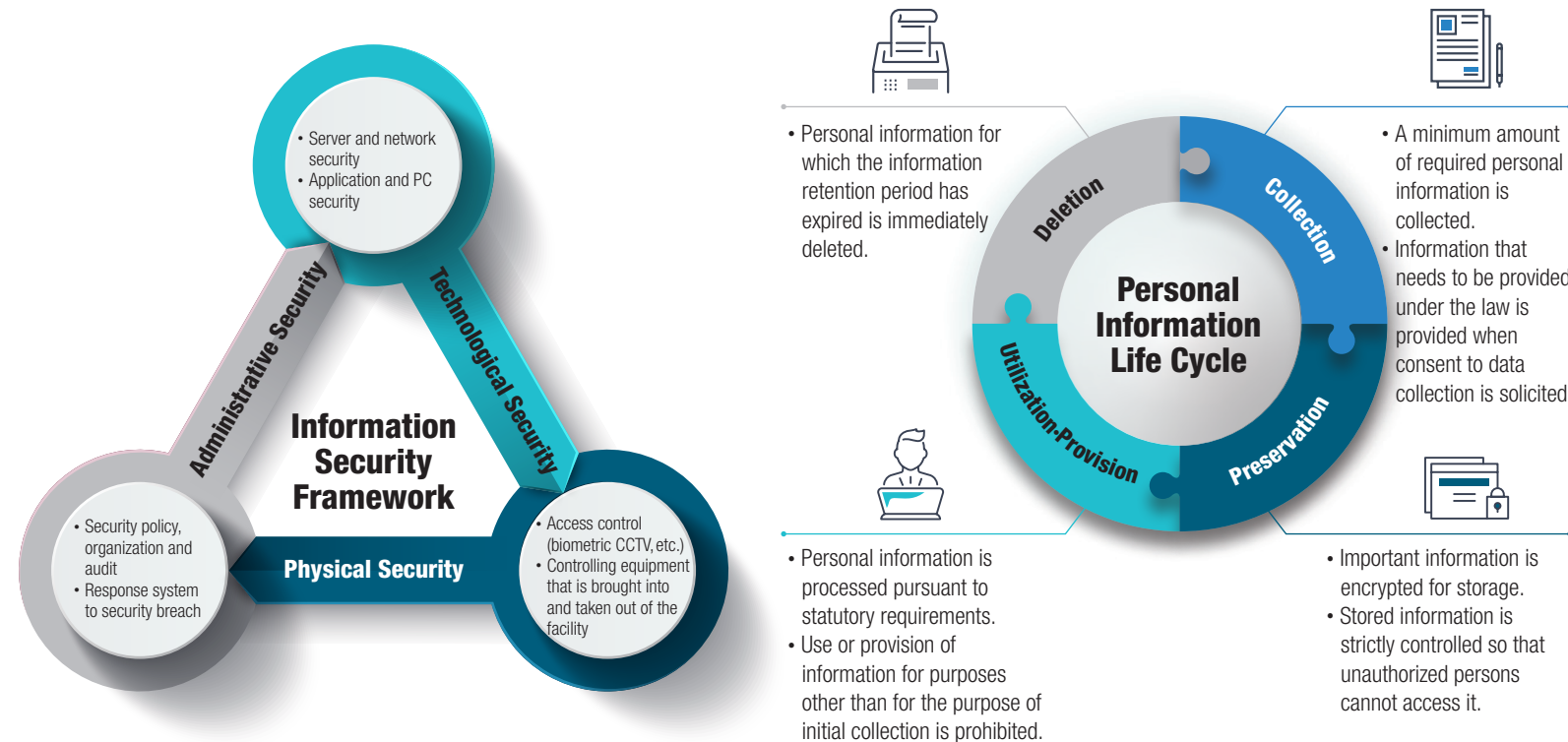


- ① Financial system (Digital budget and accounting system · government subsidy integrated management system) user training

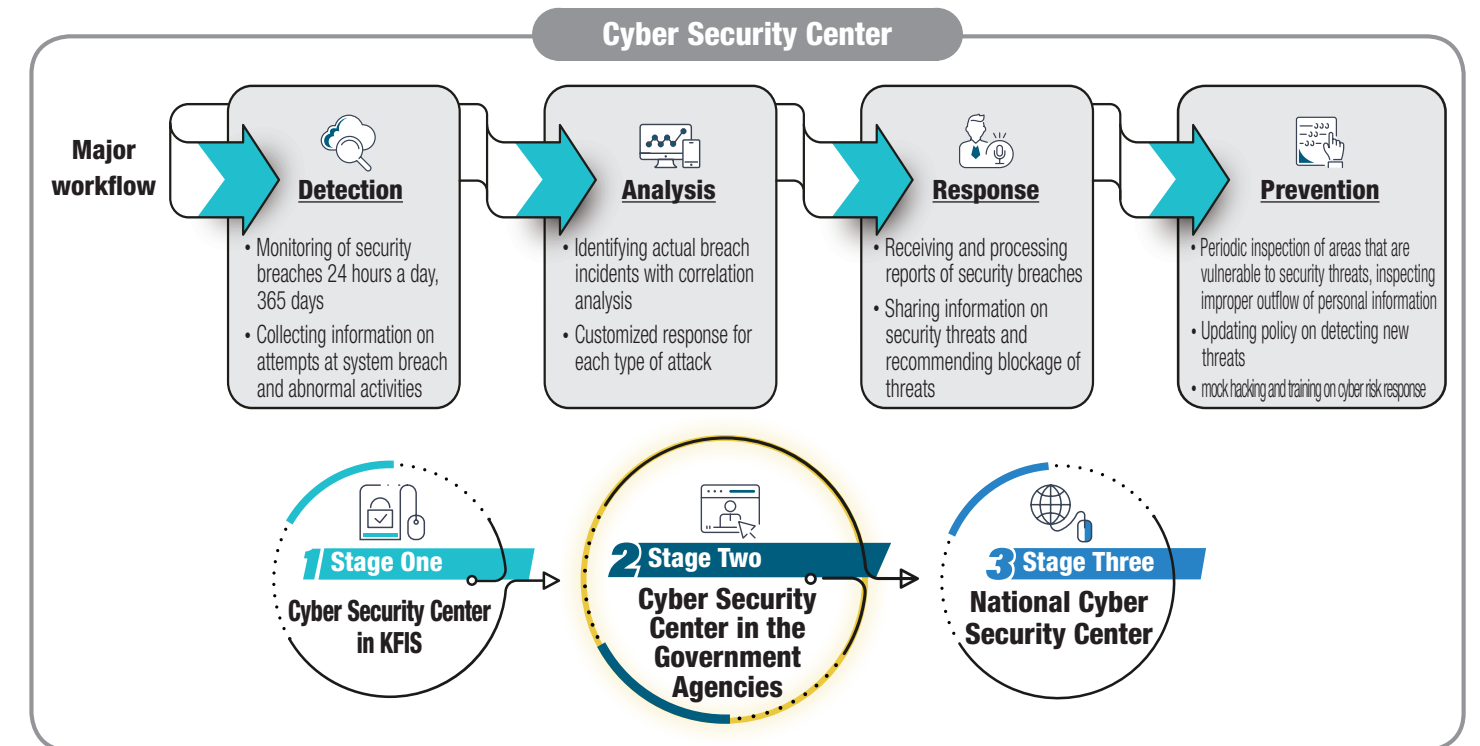
We safely administer the national fiscal system through information security and personal information protection.

- We operate information security and personal information protection system management to protect public information assets.
- We protect national fiscal data safely with the enhancement of administrative, technical and physical security.
- We prevent improper disclosure of information by managing all stages of data processing from the collection to destruction of personal information in the national fiscal system.



We ensure cybersecurity in the public finance sector by operating a cyber security center.

- We provide security control 24 hours a day, 365 days a year for 10 government agencies in public finance and planning, and prevent security threats by rapid response. (Mistry of Economy and Finanace, National Tax Service, Korea Customer Service, Public Procurement Service, Statistics Korea, Bank of Korea, Export-Import Bank, Korea Investment Corporation, Korea Minting and Security printing Corporation, Korea Fiscal Information Service)
- The security control management system is administered through the sequential process of detection, analysis, response, prevention, etc., and establish response measures.
- Preventive activities are performed such as inspection of areas that are vulnerable to security threats, mock hacking, and training on cyber risk response.



We perform analysis tasks to support policy making by fiscal authorities, and publish statistical books and public commentaries.

- We perform analysis tasks to support policy development related to public finance.
- We publish statistical books to provide timely information to fiscal authorities.
- We publish monthly "Fiscal Information Bulletin," and commentaries so that the public and researchers can easily understand and utilize fiscal information.

01 Customized support for fiscal policymaking

- Providing analysis reports using information accumulated in the financial management information system such as dBrain+, eNaraDoun
- Providing issue reports analyzing major fiscal issues
- Providing in-depth support from fiscal authorities to support efficient fiscal management

02 Producing and managing fiscal information

- Producing and managing key statistics across the field of public finance
- Providing schematized fiscal processes systematically
- Providing main statistics along with the budget processes and fiscal issues as infographics

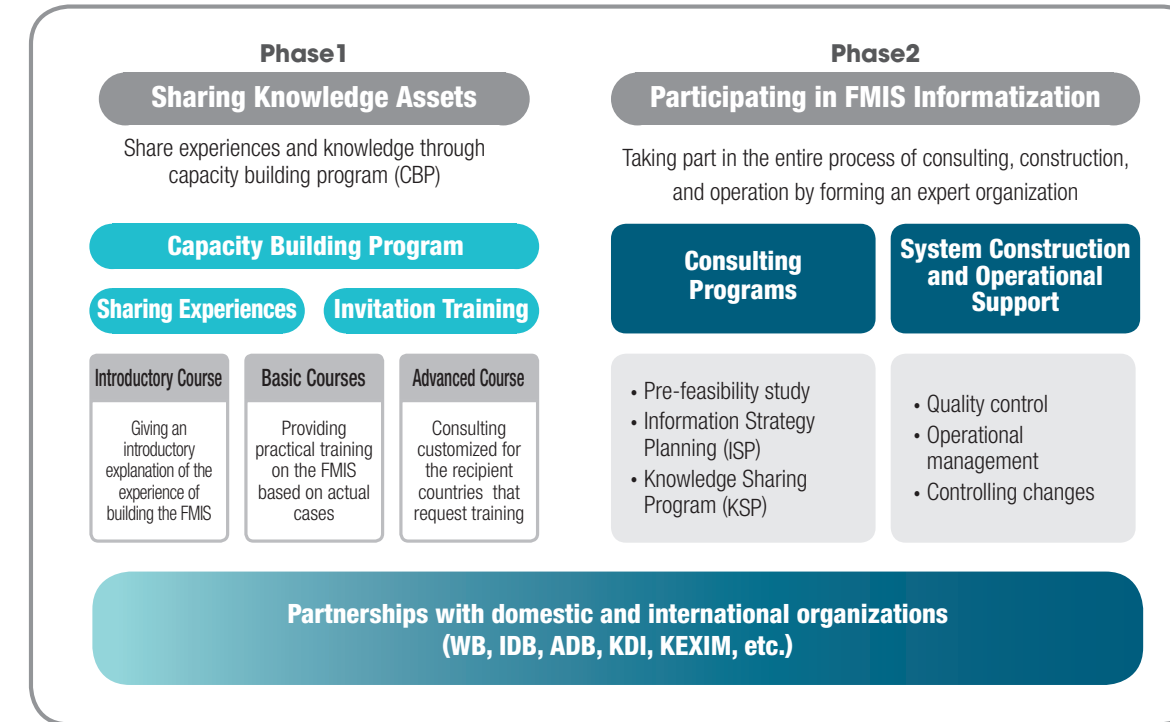
03 Providing consumer-oriented fiscal data
